

DANCE PACIFICA BALL 2011 CHAMPIONSHIP INCENTIVE RULES & PROCEDURES

GOAL the purpose of having a Championship incentive program is:

1. to encourage high level International ADULT Championship ballroom couples interested in competing at Dance Pacifica Ball 2011 (DPB11) to commit to this competition;
2. to assist with the financial responsibilities that Championship couples face; and,
3. to ensure the DPB audience views the best calibre of ballroom competition at this top level of dancing.

INCENTIVES

- All incentives are granted in Canadian funds and will be distributed at the conclusion of DPB11.
- Incentives are to recognize the financial commitment incurred by Championship couples.
- Only one Incentive is awarded a couple--therefore, if they dance both Standard and Latin, and/or, any combination of these, they would receive only ONE INCENTIVE.
- If a Partner has multiple partners, the incentive is based on a per person amount as per below.
- A partnership must complete the first round of their event to qualify; a couple entered into multiple streams (Standard and Latin) qualifies to receive the incentive if they complete one stream but, have to withdraw from the other stream(s).
- The deadline for qualifying for an incentive is: midnight, June 5, 2011, which is the close of Registration.
- Late registration and eligibility for an incentive will be decided on a case-by-case basis. Please consult the Registrar@dancepacifca.org.

- A) Couples from Outside the Province of British Columbia
- a. \$300 per couple is given to those who dance in the ADULT Championship level;

- b. For a dancer with multiple partners, the incentive is for one couple and the subsequent partnership receive \$150

B) Couples from Outside of Vancouver Island

- a. \$250 per couple is given to those who dance in the ADULT Championship level;
- b. For a dancer with multiple partners, the incentive is for one couple and the subsequent partnership receive \$125

C) Couples with an address "in and south of" Duncan, BC (District Municipality of North Cowichan)

- c. each partner of a couple that live in Duncan and below will receive a dinner meal at the Howard Johnson banquet room adjacent to the Saanich Commonwealth Centre, the meal to be served between the day session and evening competition;

D) Couples with an address north of Duncan, BC (District Municipality of North Cowichan)

- d. A free meal at the Howard Johnson banquet room adjacent to the Saanich Commonwealth Centre, the meal to be served between the day session and evening competition; and either \$50 cash or a gas coupon valued at \$50 will be given to a couple that live above Duncan;
- e. for multiple partnerships, a meal at the Howard Johnson banquet room is provided for the additional partner, and either \$25 cash or a gas coupon valued at \$25 will be given.

ADDITIONAL INCENTIVES

For the Adult competition, Dance Pacifica is pleased to announce that the prize money was increased in 2010 as per the following Table.
